1 The parties stipulated that they joined in a request that the Court extend the Case
2 Management Conference ("CMC") for 30 days to October 4, 2012, or as soon thereafter
3 as the Court may hold the CMC; and, to continue the related deadlines until 7 days
4 before the continued CMC. The parties further stipulated to continue defendants'
5 deadline to respond to the Complaint in the above-referenced Action to September 4,
6 2012.

7 Pursuant to Local Rules 6, 7-11 and 16-2(d) and the stipulations of the parties,
8 and GOOD CAUSE appearing,

9 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Case Management Conference is continued to
10 October 4, 2012 at 2:00 p.m. in Courtroom 3, 3rd Floor, Federal Building, 1301 Clay
11 Street, Oakland, California.

12 Not less than seven (7) days before the conference counsel shall file a joint CMC
13 statement addressing each of the items listed in the "Standing Order For All Judges of
14 the Northern District – Contents of Joint Case Management statement," which is attached
15 to this order and can also be found on the court's website. A proposed order is not
16 necessary. Following the conference, the court will enter its own Case Management and
17 Pretrial Order.

18 Each party shall also exchange initial disclosures and prepare a discovery plan in
19 compliance with Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 26(f) not less than seven (7) days before
20 the conference.

21 Each party shall appear personally or by counsel and should be prepared to
22 address all of the matters conferred to in this Court and with authority to enter stipulations
23 and make admissions pursuant to this Order. Any request to reschedule the date of the
24 conference shall be made in writing, and by stipulation if possible, at least ten (10) days
25 before the date of the conference and must be based upon good cause.

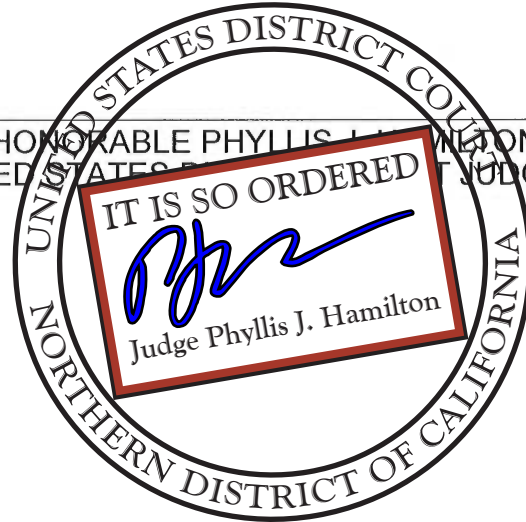
