ORDERING PRETRIAL DETENTION OF THE DEFENDANT


The undersigned is the Initial Appearance Judge in the Ninth Judicial Circuit, in and for Orange County, Florida. Pursuant to Administrative Order 2003-39-21, the undersigned acts a Circuit Judge while conducting initial appearances.

The above style case is an Orange County Case in which the Defendant had been granted pretrial release. Since the Defendant's release, the Defendant has been arrested for a new offense in Orange County, Florida in case number **2022CF3851AO**. The undersigned has reviewed the arrest report for the new offense and the undersigned has determined there is probable cause to believe the Defendant has committed a new crime while on pretrial release.

Pursuant to Fla. Stat. 903.0471 and Parker v. State, 843 So. 2d 871 (Fla. 2003), the undersigned hereby revokes the Defendant's release in the above style cause and **Orders that the Defendant be detained without bond in the above style cause**

This Order is without prejudice for the Defendant to seek pretrial release from a judge having jurisdiction to try the Defendant. See Parker, Id.
